

FFGC WEKIVA YOUTH CAMP CAMPER AGREEMENT

Please read carefully and initial on electronic registration page.

I agree to follow the rules listed below during my time at FFGC Wekiva Youth Camp.

1. I will show respect for all plant and animal life at Wekiva.
2. I will treat everyone with kindness and help make Wekiva a happy place.
3. I will leave the following at home:
 - a. Food, gum, candy
 - b. Cell phones
 - c. iPods, iPads, tablets, lap top computers and portable electronic games or devices
 - d. Jewelry or other valuable items
 - e. Weapons, including pocket knives, or other items that might be seen as a weapon
4. I will respect the camp property and I will not physically damage or write on any of the Wekiva property.
5. I will always wear closed-toes shoes and socks (as specified sub-section 5e) and wear clothing appropriate for Camp, as outlined in the following Dress Code, which is followed by campers, Staff, and Volunteers:
 - a. Clothing should be functional. Tops need to have at least two broad straps (not spaghetti). Clothing must cover the entire torso.
 - b. Shorts and skirts may be worn. Garment length should be at or below fingertips when standing straight, arms to the side.
 - c. Appropriate undergarments must be worn but may not be exposed (i.e., boxer shorts, underwear, bras). Pajamas will not be worn during normal, daytime activities.
 - d. Articles of clothing which display profanity or slogans which promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs, gangs, violence, sex or are in any other way distracting may not be worn.
 - e. Shoes and socks will be worn at all times except in the pool area. For safety reasons, sandals, shoes without a back, shoes with wheels, open toe shoes, flip-flops, shoes with cleats or shoes with built in containers are not allowed. Shoes laces and/or straps must be secured at all times. Crocs may be worn if they have the strap in place at the heel ("Adventure Mode"). Socks must be worn with Crocs unless going to and from the pool or Circle bathrooms for Shower Hour. Crocs may not be worn for activities that require running and a second pair of sneaker type shoes is necessary.
 - f. Swimsuits should be **functional** and remain in place during swimming activities. One piece swimsuits are recommended and preferred. A rashguard with bottoms is also considered functional. A shirt or towel will be worn to and from the pool area.
6. I will attend all camp meals, activities and classes.
7. I will show respect and follow the directions of all adults and counselors at camp.
8. I understand that I could be sent home for the following:
 - a. Fighting
 - b. Harassing, hurting or teasing others
 - c. Stealing
 - d. Destroying property
 - e. Using bad language or gestures
 - f. Being involved with pranks or cabin raids
 - g. Failure to obey or be respectful to my counselors, camp leaders or others at camp in charge of my care
 - h. Wandering away from my group
 - i. Anything that is seen as unsafe to others or myself
9. I understand that any "care packages" sent to camp should NOT include food items.

I have read and thought about all of these points and agree to abide by this agreement during my stay at camp. FFGC Wekiva Youth Camp reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper or staff member whose influence is considered detrimental to the overall camp program.
